He also advised that he will be working on an Ordinance and bring that forward at a later date and that he will also distribute some additional literature on the topic of the bill to the Governing Body.

City Engineer: City Engineer had nothing to report.

City Administrator: City Administrator Tim Vandall advised that the 9 Mile Creek pre-construction meeting was held and the start date will be in early November and the contractor will have 270 days to complete the project. He also advised that the comments the City had in regards to the Eisenhower Road project have been sent to the County, but no response has been received. He also mentioned that for regulations and cost reasons, the County has forgone the grant that would have aided with the project. The request for sidewalks on the south side of Eisenhower were included as an ad alternate for the request for the project, so if bids come on favorable and under budget, the City would then ask for the sidewalks to be put in on the south side of Eisenhower. If the sidewalks are not put in, the County would still grade the area for sidewalks. Tim also spoke about the McIntyre Road project and cleared up that the County originally designed the project as an arterial road, which would include the 45 mile per hour speed limit.

Ordinance No. 973 - Codification of Ordinance for the 2016 Code of the City of Lansing

At the October 27, 2016 Work Session the Council reviewed several updates to the City Code. Ordinance No. 973 adopts the codification of all updates discussed at the October 27th Work Session.

Action: Staff recommends a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 973.

ORDINANCE NO. 973

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CODIFICATION OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LANSING, KANSAS, AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 272 PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CERTAIN OTHER ORDINANCES NOT INCLUDED THEREIN, EXCEPTING CERTAIN ORDINANCES FROM REPEAL AND SAVING CERTAIN ACCRUED RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Lansing, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The codification of ordinances of the City of Lansing, Kansas, authorized by Ordinance No. 272 and K.S.A. 12-3014 and 12-3015, as set out in the following chapters, Chapters 1 to 17 and Appendices A, B, and C all inclusive, and entitled the "Code of the City of Lansing, Kansas, 2016," is hereby adopted and ordained as the "Code of the City of Lansing, Kansas, 2016," and said codification shall become effective upon publication of no fewer than 10 copies of said code in book form.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances of a general nature passed prior to the publication date of this ordinance are hereby repealed as of the date of publication of said code except as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 3. In construing this ordinance, the following ordinances shall not be considered or held to be ordinances of a general nature:

- (a) Ordinances pertaining to the acquisition of property or interests in property by gift, purchase, devise, bequest, appropriation or condemnation;
- (b) Ordinances opening, dedicating, widening, vacating or narrowing streets, avenues, alleys and boulevards;
- (c) Ordinances establishing and changing grades of streets, avenues, alleys and boulevards;
- (d) Ordinances naming or changing the names of streets, avenues and boulevards;
- (e) Ordinances authorizing or directing public improvements to be made;
- (f) Ordinances creating districts for public improvements of whatsoever kind or nature;
- (g) Ordinances levying general taxes;
- (h) Ordinances levying special assessments or taxes;
- (i) Ordinances granting any rights, privileges, easements or franchises therein mentioned to any person, firm or corporation;
- (j) Ordinances authorizing the issuance of bonds and other instruments of indebtedness by the city;
- (k) Ordinances authorizing contracts;
- (l) Ordinances establishing the limits of the city or pertaining to annexation or exclusion of territory;
- (m) Ordinances relating to compensation of officials, officers and employees of the city:
- (n) Ordinances of a temporary nature;

Provided that the above enumeration of exceptions shall not be held or deemed to be exclusive, it being the purpose and intention to exempt from repeal any and all ordinances not of a general nature and general ordinances specifically excepted by this section.

SECTION 4. The arrangement and classification of the several chapters, articles, and sections of the code adopted by Section 1 of this ordinance and the head notes and footnotes at the ends of the sections, are made for the purpose of convenience and orderly arrangement, and do not constitute a part of the ordinances, and therefore, no implication or presumption of legislative intent or construction is to be drawn therefrom.

SECTION 5. The repeal of ordinances as provided in Section 2 hereof, shall not affect any rights acquired, fines, penalties, forfeitures or liabilities incurred thereunder, or actions involving any of the provisions of said ordinances or parts thereof. Said ordinances above repealed are hereby continued in force and effect after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance for the purpose of such rights, fines, penalties, forfeitures, liabilities and actions therefor.

SECTION 6. If for any reason any chapter, article, section, subsection, sentence, portion or part of the "Code of the City of Lansing, Kansas, 2016," or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this code.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the publication of the "Code of the City of Lansing, Kansas, 2016," as provided in K.S.A. 12-3015.

Reservation of up to 500 Tons of Street De-icing Salt

Lansing Public Works participated again this year in a group purchasing bid process with Leavenworth County and the other cities in the county. This agreement guarantees up to 500 tons of salt. We are not obligated to take delivery of the entire amount, and the price is guaranteed for the 2016-2017 winter season for additional salt as available beyond 500 tons if we need it.

The low bid from Hutchinson Salt Company of Baxter Springs, Kansas, was accepted by the county. The bid amount was \$52.85/ton delivered to our Service Center. We have sufficient salt on hand for the remainder of 2016, and ice control is funded in Fund 22, Consolidated Street and Highway, Line 22-014-42200 at \$35,000 for 2017.

To formalize Lansing's acceptance of the bid, we need City Council approval.

Action: Approve the bid of Hutchinson Salt Company of Baxter Springs, Kansas, for de-icing salt at delivered unit price of \$52.85/ton, and authorize the Public Works Department to purchase up to 500 tons as needed.
